UPDATE 9/6/2019 @ 8:09 a.m. Evacuation Orders for Montanya Place, Bonita Place, Belcara Place, Lone Oak Way, streets south of Calle del Oso Oro and Trails Circle have been **DOWNGRADED** to Evacuation **WARNINGS**.

The Evacuation Warnings for Bear Creek and Copper Canyon remain in Place. While this is a positive change, we want to remind residents to remain vigilant and be prepared to leave at a moment's notice.

UPDATE 9/6/2019 @ 6:12 a.m. - The fire remains 2000 acres and is now 20% contained. Clinton Keith is still closed. Los Gatos, Via Volcano and Tenaja Road are open. The next update will be later this morning.
